A natural story-teller, Matt Boylan-Smith left his home town of Bathurst to write, travel the world and tell people his tales.

Having reached number three in the overall Triple J unearthed charts in 2013 with his song "three words," Matt Boylan-Smith started a side project with Alora and Senii (Finland). They have generated three songs with their collaboration "Down by the Ocean" reaching the viral top 30 in both Germany and Finland on Spotify and exceeding 2.5 million streams.

Matt Boylan-Smith then recorded tracks with producer Jeff Martin (The Tea Party) and his pre-release tours have received rave reviews from audiences in Europe, South America and Australia.

2017 saw Matt Boylan-Smith provide the pre-match entertainment for the National Rugby League and gain national radio play on Triple J with his single We Can Be Together. His film clip for the unreleased track Johnny' was recently recognised as the winner of the Madrid International film festival in the best shorts competition.

He has recently paired up with engineer and producer Lon LeMaster (Toto 4, Don Henley) and Beau Hill (Alice Cooper, Winger, Kix, Ratt) to complete his recordings and work on new tracks at Studio 301 with Stefan Durant helping mix and Steve Smart completing the masters.
